Dear raiders,

Happy Raid Year! Time is getting close, less than 5 weeks to the start.

The weather is getting colder in the North, but Southern parts of Finland have stayed "warm" most of the time. Anyway, Christmas was white all over the country. The lowest temperatures in Lapland have been around -35C, but also sometimes above zero. At the moment it looks quite typical, have a look at http://www.fmi.fi/en/

From 22nd Dec the days have been getting a little longer again, but still at the moment the sun do not rise at all in Lapland. When the raid starts, we will have some glow of daylight again.

There has been two cancels in the team list (team 12 Schelewski/Knab and 35 van der Lelie) and some changes of codrivers (teams 36, 37 and 39). You can see the present situation from the website. We are now 40 2CVs and 80 people and there are still teams in the waiting list.

December 20 was the deadline for the arrival of the Enquiry Forms, but a few are still missing. The forms of teams 2, 10, 23, 27, 38 and 40 havenot arrived by today. Also a few second hand drivers (yes, that is co-driver in our raid language) have not sent their form. It is very important for the organising work that every team returns it.

Cold starting experiences

I met strange starting problems with two of our 2CVs in the beginning of the winter. Normally the cars would start wonderfully, but now it was very unstable and the engine stopped several times before running steadily. The reason in both cases was a missing tiny spring which connects the choke lever to the carburretter body (see the attached image carb_spring). As the spring is gone, everything feels and even looks normal when using the choke. When the engine starts, the choke lever (without the pull from the spring) makes freestyle movements changing the mixture constantly. In warmer weather the choke is not fully needed and one do not recognize the problem. Check if this spring still exists, I have noticed that it is often gone or broken from the other end.

On the top of newer twin carburretters there is a vacuum operated unit on the right hand side (see the attached image carb_lockthis). After cold starting this device automatically pulls the choke lever off a little bit. I suppose the reason for this are some anti-pollution regulations, but in -20 or colder this device may ruin your starting attempts. It is easy to lock the unit out of order. It has no other effect to the carburretter.


Other things
